As a reminder to RCM's please bring back to areas and groups the possibility of adding to regional policy that all flyers at the regional table should include a date, revised date, or last updated date. The current policy regarding flyers is "III.B.1. All flyers at the regional table pertaining to NA display at least one (1) of the four (4) approved NA symbols. (see Intellectual property bulletin #1 & #2 revised). (10/99)." This is especially important for regional service committee flyers that include meeting places and times. GSR's who are not involved with Regional service may not be aware of changes and this is one way we can improve communication within the service structure. In the old days before most groups kept the announcements in page protectors it was easier to tell which flyers were old! Areas and groups should also consider a motion to add to regional policy that all copies of regional policy contain a last revised date on each page. This does not pertain to my commitment and a motion for this would need to come from an RCM, so I can only make a suggestion!

NEZF Literature Workshop

I have been contacted by Steve C., the NJ Regional Literature Review Chair about setting up a Literature Workshop at the Northeast Zonal Forum. I forwarded the email to Jim H. (Regional Chair) and Melinda S. (previous RD.) I was also contacted by Jeff, the Mid Atlantic Regional Literature Chair. Regional Literature chair is also out to the fellowship.
